Are you looking for a way to enrich your travel experience at an unbelievably low price? The SMART Travel Program has helped our members save hundreds traveling throughout North America, Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean. Our SMART leadership team works hard to bring our members the very best experience participating in the SMART Travel Program, and we need your help.

An online Travel Program Survey was developed to allow all our members the opportunity to easily provide input.

Previously, it was sent to all SMART members via Vertical Response.

If you haven't submitted your input yet, just click <u>https://www.smartrving.org/Caravans/</u> <u>CaravanSurvey.php</u> which will take you to the SMART website to sign-in and access the survey. If you submit a response and decide to change your input, no problem, just submit another and the new submission is saved and the previous one is deleted. If you decide NOT to take the survey, it's assumed you are NOT interested in any caravans or cruises.

There is one important issue to be aware of;

Only members can take the survey because one has to go to the website and sign-in. If spouses or traveling companions who do not have a member number use the Pilot's membership number and take it after the Pilot submitted one, the last one submitted is retained and the first one is deleted. If both have a member number, they are encouraged to submit separate survey responses.

The survey is anonymous unless you indicate you want to serve as a Wagon Master or Assistant.
